Uniform Policy

Effective: as of 15 AUGUST 2024

1. Scope

1.1. Personal scope

This uniform policy applies to all pupils (children), who are students of ISB, and their legal representatives.

1.2. Objective scope

These uniform regulations apply to school days and non-teaching working days of the school year, regardless of whether the educational activity takes place at the premises of ISB or at an external location, regardless of whether it is a lesson, classroom activity, workshop or any other programme.

If ISB organises a programme related to its educational activities (such as, in particular, class trips, visits to museums, theatres, cinemas, academic or sports competitions, meetings with sister schools) on days other than school days or non-school working days, the present uniform policy shall also apply to these programmes, unless ISB provides otherwise.

1.3. Period of validity

This Uniform Policy shall enter into force upon its publication and shall apply from the date of its entry into force.

2. Fundamental provisions

2.1. Wearing the uniform

Wearing the uniform

- for all pupils (children) who are students of ISB, i.e. from Preparatory to grade 12;
- throughout the entire school year;
- during all school programmes;
- regardless of venue

is compulsory.

ISB reserves the right to ask students to wear any part of the uniform on other occasions when it represents the ISB community and spirit. The school will communicate such a request to parents by newsletter or email, with this letter being made available no later than 12:00 noon on the third (3rd) day prior to the occasion.

2.2. The Uniform

2.2.1. Everyday uniform

From preparatory to grade 10:

- white T-shirt with ISB logo or white blouse/shirt with ISB logo; and
- blue jumper / cardigan / hoodie with ISB logo; and
- free choice of knee-length dark blue skirt/knee-length trousers/long trousers or dark blue jeans (without branding or logo; long trousers cannot be leisure trousers); and
- for girls if wearing a skirt body-coloured or dark blue nylon or cotton tights or socks; and

- shoes, sandals of your choice (but not flip-flops, crocs or mules)

Grades 11-12 (smart casual)

- T-shirt, blouse, shirt (without branding or logo) in a dark, subdued colour of your choice; and
- jumper/cardigan (without branding or logo) of your choice in white or a subdued colour (blue, black, grey, brown); and
- a knee-length skirt/knee-length trousers/long trousers or jeans (without branding or logo; long trousers cannot be leisure trousers) in white or a subdued colour (blue, black, grey, brown) of your choice; and
- for girls if wearing a skirt body-coloured, dark blue or black cotton tights or socks;
 and
- dark shoes of your choice (blue or black), sandals (but not flip-flops, crocs or mules).

2.2.2. Formal uniform (Compulsory formal uniform for school events)

Preparatory-Grades 5:

- equally for boys and girls: white, soft collar polo shirts with ISB logo on,
- for girls: of your choice (until the school specifies the exact type) of knee-length dark blue fabric skirt or dark blue long trousers (long trousers cannot be leisure trousers or jeans, skirts cannot be jeans); and
- for boys: of your choice (until the school specifies the exact type) of dark blue long trousers (no branding, no logo; cannot be leisure trousers or jeans); and
- for girls if wearing a skirt body-coloured or dark blue nylon or cotton tights or socks; and
- boys and girls alike are free to choose elegant, dark-coloured (black or blue) formal shoes [(without branding or logo, lace-up shoes for boys; formal shoes for girls not high heels (no higher than 3 cm)].

Grades 6-10:

- for boys and girls alike, a white hard-collar, button-down blouse or shirt with ISB logo, and
- for girls, a knee-length navy blue fabric skirt with ISB inscription or (until the school specifies the exact type) a pair of navy blue long trousers of your choice (long trousers cannot be leisure trousers or jeans); and
- for boys (until the school specifies the exact type) dark blue long trousers (no branding, no logo; cannot be leisure trousers or jeans); and
- for girls if wearing a skirt body-coloured, dark blue or black cotton tights or socks;
- boys and girls alike are free to choose elegant, dark-coloured (black or blue) formal shoes [(without branding or logo), boys' formal shoes with laces, girls' formal shoes with no high heels (no more than 3 cm high)].

2.2.3. Physical education and sports uniforms

In all grades and in all cases (unless otherwise specified by the PE teacher):

- white ISB athletics shirt;
- dark blue ISB athletics shorts;
- ISB leisurewear (hoodie and trousers);
- sports shoes

3. Clothing or garments not permitted

The following items of clothing and accessories will not be tolerated by ISB - i.e. they are not to be worn in school:

- garments or accessories in bright or gaudy colours;
- garments that are too baggy, too tight, low-cut garments, garments that do not cover the waist, miniskirts, hot pants;
- accident-prone accessories, jewellery;
- shoes with soles or heels higher than 3 cm;
- footwear that does not support the foot (flip-flops, crocs, mules, etc.);
- ISB recommends that make-up should be avoided; very moderate make-up is permissible for pupils over 15 years of age.
- 4. Legal consequences of breaching the dress code
- 4.1. If the student is required to wear the uniform on an occasion when the uniform is required by this policy or at the request of the school, and the student is not wearing the uniform, and ISB's stock permits, ISB will provide the student with the uniform required by this policy. The uniform so provided to the student shall be returned by the student within five (5) days, washed and ironed. If the student fails to comply with this obligation, the parent shall be obliged to pay the cost of the uniform provided to the student within 15 (fifteen) days by bank transfer. In this case, ISB shall issue and send an invoice for the purchase price to the parent by electronic means.
- 4.2. If the provisions of paragraph 4.1 cannot be applied (either due to lack of available capacity or due to the specificities of the occasion), in the event that a student arrives for a school day, a non-teaching day or an event in a dress not in accordance with this policy or the dress code of ISB, the class teacher or, in their absence, the subject teacher may prohibit the student from attending the event, unless the student is willing to change their dress code to comply with the above rules.

5. Purchasing the uniforms

The mandatory clothing items listed above can be obtained from unimode.hu/isb

6. Publication of the policy

This uniform policy shall enter into force upon its adoption and shall be made available to parents by the school through one of the following communication channels:

- an e-mail sent to the parent's registered e-mail address,
- in a newsletter,
- or by uploading the policy to a separate electronic password-protected storage area with at least a one-time access for parents (together referred to as "parental communication channels").
