Uniform Policy

2025-2026

Effective from 1 September 2025

School uniform

At the International School of Budapest (ISB), our uniform promotes unity, a sense of belonging, and pride in our school community. This policy outlines what students are expected to wear and when.

Who this policy is for

This policy applies to all students at ISB (Preparatory to Grade 12) and their parents or guardians. It applies to all school days, as well as school-organised events, whether on campus or offsite.

When uniforms are required

Students are required to wear the appropriate school uniform:

- On all school days throughout the academic year
- At all school-organised events and activities, including those held offsite (e.g. field trips, performances, academic or sports competitions)

The school may also request uniforms to be worn for other school-related occasions. Parents will be informed at least three days in advance via email or newsletter.

Wearing a school uniform is compulsory.

Failure to comply with the uniform policy may result in disciplinary action, including being sent home or asked to be picked up by a parent/guardian.

What students should wear

Everyday Uniform (Preparatory to Grade 10)

- White ISB-logo polo-shirt or ISB blouse/shirt
- Light blue knitted jumper, cardigan, or hoodie. All with ISB logo
- From Grade 6: students may also choose to wear a dark blue ISB hoodie, blue knitted jumper or cardigan. All with ISB logo
- Knee-length or longer dark blue skirt, knee-length or long dark blue trousers (no logos, no jeans of any colour, no casual/sport trousers)

Everyday Uniform (Grade 11 and 12)

- From Grade 11: students must wear an ISB blazer and trousers*
- If wearing a skirt: body-coloured or dark blue tights or socks must be worn
- Dark-coloured shoes or sandals (no flip-flops, Crocs, or mules)

*Grade 12 students may wear the ISB blazer and trousers but are also allowed to wear their own blazer and trousers in a dark blue or black colour.

Formal uniform (For official school events)

Preparatory to Grade 5

- White polo shirt with ISB logo
- Girls: dark blue skirt or trousers (no jeans or casual wear)
- Boys: dark blue trousers (no jeans or casual wear)
- Dark formal shoes (no logos; boys' shoes with laces, girls' shoes with heels no higher than 3 cm)

Grades 6–10

- White button-down shirt or blouse with ISB logo
- Girls: dark blue skirt with ISB inscription or dark blue trousers (no jeans or casual wear)
- Boys: dark blue trousers (no jeans or casual wear)
- Optional: dark or light blue knitted jumper or cardigan. All with the ISB logo
- Dark formal shoes (no logos; boys' shoes with laces, girls' shoes with low heels – max. 3 cm)

Grade 11 and 12

- Grade 11: ISB blazer and trousers
- Grade 12: ISB blazer and trousers or own blazer and trousers in a dark blue or black colour.

PE and sports uniform

(For all grades, unless the PE teacher specifies otherwise)

- White or dark blue ISB athletics shirt
- Dark blue ISB athletics shorts or skirt
- ISB hoodie and trousers
- Sports shoes with **completely white soles** (required for indoor use)

Students who do not wear the correct PE shoes may not participate in the lesson and will be marked with an unexcused absence.

What not to wear

To maintain consistency and safety, the following are not permitted:

- Bright, flashy colours
- Clothing that is overly loose, tight, low-cut, or exposes the midriff
- Miniskirts or short shorts
- Unsafe accessories or large jewellery
- Shoes with heels over 3 cm, flip-flops, Crocs, or mules
- Hats are not to be worn in school

Make-up is discouraged. Light make-up is allowed for students over 15.
