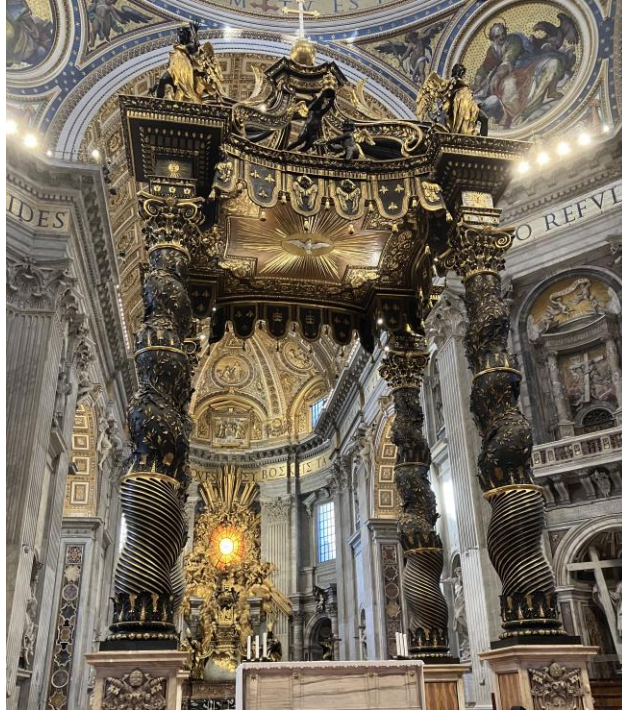

The Colosseum



- Built nearly 2,000 years ago
- Could hold around 50,000 spectators
- Symbol of Ancient Rome
- One of the most famous landmarks in the world

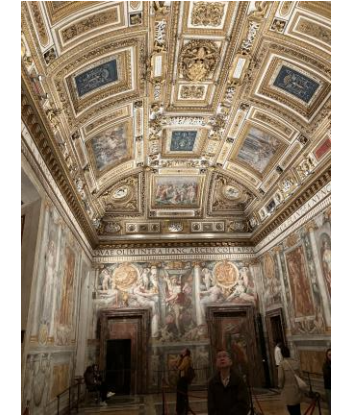


St. Peter's Basilica

- One of the largest churches in the world
- Home of Michelangelo's Pietà
- Contains connections to Hungary:
 - - St. Stephen Chapel
 - - Esztergom Basilica floor marker

Castel Sant'Angelo

- Originally built as Emperor Hadrian's tomb
- Later became a fortress and papal refuge
- Connected to the Vatican by a secret passage





Trastevere

- One of the most authentic neighborhoods in Rome
- Narrow streets, local restaurants, lively evenings
- Felt like the 'real' everyday Rome



Italian Daily Life

- Coffee culture is very different
- Italians drink espresso quickly at the bar
- Dinner is often much later than in Hungary
- Relaxed lifestyle: 'La dolce vita'
